In 1993, Earthbeat was born, beginning a “volunteer revolution!” Since then, Earthbeat has become a yearly event where over 500 youth and young adults donate one full day to serving this community. Earthbeat has become the largest annual environmental volunteer event in the Stateline area!

In May of 2009, over 800 Earthbeat volunteers cleaned local creeks, parks, roads, nature centers, and forests, as well as painting and restoring playground equipment; donating over 4,797 hours of service to the City of Rockford, the Park District, and various municipalities. The volunteers cleaned a total of 40 work sites resulting in over 30 tons of trash being collected. Earthbeat, with the help of our corporate and individual partnerships, was able to distribute \$50,000.00 into local youth organizations, mentorship programs, foster care groups, and civic organizations.

On May 8th, 2010, an enormous volunteerism impact will again take place in the Stateline. Earthbeat will serve the community through worthwhile service projects; accomplishing the following goals:
