It was then that Earthbeat was created and, in turn, started a “volunteer revolution!” From the beginning, this has been a full, one-day event where hundreds of youth and young adults donate their time serving the Rockford community. And now, Earthbeat has become one of the largest volunteer movements in the Illinois Stateline area!

In 2015, Earthbeat made a decision to not only serve the local community but to serve the entire Stateline area in as many ways as possible. Volunteers began partnering with local High Schools and Middle Schools, community-based organizations, and the Rockford Park District. Because of their efforts, the local creeks, parks, nature centers, and forests were cleaned and restored. In one year, these volunteers donated over 6,000 hours of service to the City of Rockford, the Rockford Park District, and various municipalities. With the help of our corporate partnerships, Earthbeat was able to distribute \$20,000 to local youth organizations, mentorship programs, foster care groups, and civic organizations.

This year, we will kick-off our enormous volunteerism initiative in the Stateline area on May 7th. Earthbeat will serve the community through worthwhile service projects and will ultimately accomplish the following goals:

- Promote volunteerism in the community
- Empower youth and young adults to serve in their community on a consistent basis
